

DUES AND PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Slug Aquatics membership dues are considered “Annual Dues” as opposed to monthly fees. The annual dues can be paid monthly, quarterly, or semi-annually. Regardless of which option is selected, payments are due between the 1st and the 10th of each month that the payment is due. A \$25 late charge will be assessed for payments not received by the 30th of the month. **If you are unable to make your payment by the 10th of the month, contact the head coach Joan McCallum (jrmccall@ucsc.edu) or the Team Treasurer, Monica Carney (seaslug00@gmail.com) for alternate arrangements.** Dues may be mailed or dropped off at the pool. If dropping off at the pool, do not hand it to a coach – please put it into the appropriate folder in the Slug Box. **Make checks payable to “UC Regents”.** In the memo line, please write the name of the swimmer and the month(s) you are paying for. New swimmers are to pay the current month’s dues plus the sign-up fee when registering.

Costs for joining Slug Aquatics (effective 10/1/14)

Sign-up Fee:	\$75 per child
Swimmer – 13 years and older	\$90
Swimmer – 9 to 12 years old	\$80
Swimmer – 8 years and younger	\$65

Families with multiple children receive a 25% discount for each additional swimmer.

Example: Two swimmers ages 16 and 13 years old:
Total dues per month: \$158 (\$90 + \$68)

Two swimmers ages 14 and 9 years old:
Total dues per month: \$150 (\$90 + \$60)

Two swimmers ages 10 and 8 years old:
Total dues per month: \$129 (\$80 + \$49)

Two swimmers ages 8 and 6 years old:
Total dues per month: \$114 (\$65 + \$49)

Swimmers who are quitting the team or taking a leave of absence will be expected to notify the Head Coach in advance, in writing, of their last day of practice. The notice may be emailed to jrmccall@ucsc.edu or placed in the Monthly Dues folder at the pool. Informing the coaches, without written confirmation, does not satisfy notice requirements. *Without written notice,*

monthly dues including late fees will be charged. Swimmers who quit the team will be removed from the email list and will need to rejoin the team (by paying the sign-up fee). Swimmers who take a leave of absence will be expected to continue to pay dues and will be left on the email list. They are not required to rejoin the team prior to returning to swimming. This includes swimmers taking a break for high school swimming and/or other sports. If quitting, your spot on the team is relinquished. If you wish to return and space allows it, then you will be responsible for paying the sign-up fee as well as the currently monthly dues. If you are taking a leave of absence, 100% dues are required to hold your spot on the team.

All swimmers must be members of Pacific Swimming. Pacific Swimming carries an accident policy that covers our team at both meets and practices. This membership is renewable through the team every year in mid November.
